STEPS FOR MAKING E15 AVAILABLE



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- 1. File a mis-fueling mitigation plan with the U.S. EPA. This is a simple process and requires sending a letter agreeing to follow the <u>industry</u> mis-fueling plan. Growth Energy can provide you with a standard letter and help with the EPA registration.
- 2. Agree to participate in the industry survey program with the RFG Survey Association, including a nominal registration fee. <u>Click Here to learn more</u>.
- 3. Properly label the fuel using the <u>EPA approved fuel</u> label which can be obtained free of charge from <u>Growth Energy</u> (search for part number U-AME-EPA15). Also, post the appropriate FTC octane button (usually 88 or 87) to the dispenser
- 4. Ensure that all of your product transfer documents contain the correct information regarding volume percentage of ethanol.
- 5. Be sure to check your state and local regulations regarding proper blends of ethanol in your area including checking with your local fire marshal or authority having jurisdiction (AHJ) about your facility's compatibility with pumping E15.
- 6. Ensure your fuel and ethanol provider has applied and received approval for E15 supply.



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
